Pastoral Ponderings

As of this past Sunday I have been with you for one year. Last fall I was asked if I would do pulpit supply from the Sunday after Thanksgiving through the end of the year. Pastor Don was retiring in mid-December and someone was needed to fill in. I was quite happy to do so as I enjoyed being a supply preacher at Cape Neddick for the last five years. What started as a week to week fill-in soon led to being called as your interim pastor.

I believe the Sunday after Thanksgiving was the first Sunday in Advent last year. My wife, Cyndi, a specifically trained interim minister would often preach during this time of

year about pregnancy in the churches she was serving. Advent is a pregnant season. There is the annunciation to Mary that she will bear a child. Sometimes that pregnancy is filled with consternation as we read of it in Matthew 1. Sometimes it is filled with wonder, dread, and expectation as we find it in Luke. Surely, the church between pastors is a pregnant time. Something is being born. There is the waiting in expectation. Anyhow, that first Sunday, knowing that Pastor Don was leaving, and knowing that you as a congregation did not know what to expect, was the right time to preach about pregnancy.

Now it is a year later, and the first Sunday of Advent is a few days away. It has

been a good year for me. I have enjoyed being your interim pastor. I have gotten to know you as I would not have simply being the pulpit supply that comes in once a week. Now we are at a different place in our relationship perhaps best characterized as waiting. The pulpit committee has done yeoman service in gathering all its material and producing a profile for prospective candidates. As far as I know that profile has begun to circulate. Now, the church waits; waits for someone to respond and may wait further for that right person. Sometimes that wait can be a long time as the Holy Spirit, just like children in the womb, does not work according to our time tables.

So where do we go from here? I often feel at this time of year that we need to see beyond the celebrated event, Jesus coming into the world, to the ongoing imperative for Christ to be born in us anew. "My little children, for whom, I am in the pain of childbirth until Christ is formed in you," Galatians 4:19. Unless Jesus Christ is formed in us, we become stale, perhaps even stagnant in our faith. Our faith should be an ongoing process of rebirth.

Perhaps one of the sad things about how we celebrate Christmas is that we treat it as a past event. After it is over, we won't think about it until next year. However, God, the living God, is not consigned to times past but is present and leads us into the future. Christmas is not just about the past but also the future. Jesus awaits to be born anew in us. Help me in the year ahead to work with you about what that means for us at Cape Neddick Baptist Church.
