## **PASTOR'S PONDERINGS**

Rock of Ages is a well-known hymn. The words of this hymn were originally penned on the back of a playing card, the six of diamonds!!

It seems that Rev. Augustus Toplady was caught one day in a violent thunderstorm. There was no shelter nearby, but there was a huge cleft running down a ledge beside the road. So Toplady took refuge there. As he was protected from the effects of the storm he was reminded of how God is a refuge in the storms of life. A poem came quickly to his mind, yet he had no paper to write on. He then saw on the ground a playing card...and so it was on a six of diamonds that Toplady wrote these words:

Rock of ages, cleft for me,  
Let me hide myself in Thee.  
Let the water and the blood,  
From Thy riven side which  
flowed,  
Be of sin the double cure,  
Cleanse me from its guilt and  
pow'er

As you can see the words apply to much more than Jesus being a refuge in a storm of life. These words remind us that we can also hide in Jesus when it comes to our sins. It is through Christ, and Christ alone, that we are saved from the penalty and punishment of sin. As we make our way through Lent and look to Holy Week at the end of this month, may we remember the price that Jesus paid so that we might be saved!! Let's never take the cross for granted.
