PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

It is often said that Maine has five seasons: spring, summer, fall, winter.....and mud. Hearing this may bring a smile to your face, or it might bring a knowing frown, for mud season is real!! It runs roughly from late March to mid-May, and so you've probably noticed that we are now in the midst of this 'watch where you step' season.'
